Tennessee went 4-8 and 0-8 in SEC play in 2017. Brady Hoke coached the final two games of the season as UT's interim head coach. Butch Jones was relieved of his position as the Vols' head coach following a Nov. 11 road loss to Missouri. Three of UT's eight losses were by six points or less.

Junior running back John Kelly led the Vols offensively, rushing for 778 yards and nine scores and catching 37 passes for 299 yards.

Redshirt freshman Jarrett Guarantano took over as UT's starting quarterback against South Carolina and finished wth season with 997 passing yards, four passing touchdowns, two interceptions and a 61.9 completion

percentage.

Highly-touted freshman offensive lineman Trey Smith started every game, led the team in pancake blocks and earned FWAA Freshman All-America honors.

Senior tight end Ethan Wolf finished his collegiate career with 91 receptions (second-most by a UT tight end) for 998 yards (third-most) and seven touchdowns.

On defense, redshirt senior defensive tackle Kendal Vickers served as the unit's leader and finished his career with 38-consecutive starts. Sophomores Daniel Bituli (90 tackles) and Nigel Warrior (83 tackles) paced the Vols in tackles and each recorded a pick-six in SEC play.

- Tennessee rallied back from 14-point deficit to take a thrilling 42-41 double-overtime win over Georgia Tech in the Chick-fil-A Kickoff Game at Mercedes-Benz Stadium.
- UT went into overtime for the second-consecutive season opener. Kelly punched in a touchdown from one yard out in the first overtime
 to match a one-yard touchdown run by Georgia Tech quarterback TaQuon Marshall and keep the game timed at 35-35. In the second
 overtime, Kelly punched in a score from two yards out to put the Vols up 42-35. Georgia Tech found the end zone with a 13-yard run by
 Marshall on its ensuing possession and decided to go for a two-point conversion. The UT defense came up with a huge stop to seal the
 42-41 victory. UT redshirt sophomore defensive end Darrell Taylor forced an incomplete pass by Marshall on the conversion attempt.
- Making his first career start at quarterback, junior Quinten Dormady helped lead a second-half surge and completed 20 of 37 passes for 221 yards and two scores. He also had two rushes for 13 yards. Dormady was outstanding in the second half and overtime, going 12-for-17 169 yards and two touchdowns.
- Junior running back John Kelly led UT's ground attack, gaining 128 yards and four scores on 19 carries. His four rushing scores tied for
 the second-most in a game in UT history and the most by a Vol since James Stewart rushed for four scores at Georgia in 1994. Kelly also
 caught five passes for 35 yards.
- Sophomore receiver Marquez Callaway enjoyed a breakout game, catching four passes for 115 yards and two touchdowns. His 10-yard touchdown reception with 42 seconds left in the third quarter drew the Vols to within 21-14. With 11:49 on the clock in the fourth quarter, Callaway sprinted down the left sideline for a 50-yard touchdown catch.
- With 4:50 left in the game, redshirt junior defensive back Rashaan Gaulden forced a fumble that was recovered by junior safety Micah Abernathy at Tennessee's seven-yard line. The Vols then marched 93 yards down the field using a 40-yard catch by Callaway and two runs by Kelly for 27 yards and a touchdown to tie the game, 28-28.
- Redshirt senior defensive tackle Paul Bain blocked a 36-yard field goal attempt by Shawn Davis with time expiring to send the game into
 overtime.

- Tennessee opened the game with a bang as true freshman running back Ty Chandler returned the opening kickoff 91 yards for a score, giving the Vols a quick, 7-0 lead. Chandler's 91-yard touchdown run marked the first time a Vol had returned the game's opening kickoff for a score since Evan Berry had a 96-yard return against Arkansas on Oct. 3, 2015. Chandler is the first UT true freshman with a kickoff return touchdown since Leonard Scott took one 100 yards against Georgia in 1999. Chandler's score marked the 11th kick or punt return for a touchdown in the Butch Jones era.
- UT junior quarterback Quinten Dormady connected on 13 of 18 passes for 194 yards and two touchdowns. Junior running back John Kelly racked up 140 yards of total offense, rushing for 80 yards on 18 carries and totaling 60 receiving yards on five catches. Sophomore running back Carlin Fils-aime rushed for 41 yards and two touchdowns on three carries.

- Tennessee junior running back John Kelly rushed for 101 yards and junior quarterback Quinten Dormady threw for 187 yards as Tennessee held on to defeat UMass. 17-13.
- The Vols got on the board first when Kelly scored his sixth touchdown of the season with a 12-yard run, which was set up by a 66-yard pass—Tennessee's longest play from scrimmage this season—from Dormady to sophomore receiver Brandon Johnson. Kelly's score gave the Vols a 7-0 lead in the second quarter.
- · UMass responded in the second quarter, pulling to within 7-6 when quarterback Ross Comis ran it in from five yards out to cap a fiveplay, 75-yard drive. The Minutemen missed the ensuing PAT to keep the Vols on top.
- With 25 seconds remaining in the first half, Dormady hit sophomore receiver Tyler Byrd for an eight-yard touchdown pass in the back corner of the end zone, giving the Vols a 14-6 halftime lead.
- After an Aaron Medley 40-yard field goal midway through the third guarter. UMass took its second drive of the second half 75 yards down the field, finishing with a 13-yard touchdown pass from Andrew Ford to Sadiq Palmer to cut the Vols lead to 17-13.
- Kelly, who rushed for 80 yards in the first half, recorded his third 100-yard rushing game of the season with 101 yards and one touchdown on 25 carries.
- Dormady finished 17-for-27 for 187 yards and one touchdown to earn his third win as UT's starting quarterback.
- Johnson posted career highs with seven receptions for 123 yards.
- Tennessee's defense buckled down and held on to preserve the Vols' perfect home record, holding the Minutemen to just 281 yards of total offense. UMass finished 3-for-14 on third-down conversion attempts and failed to convert on fourth-down.
- Tennessee also had seven sacks, 12 TFLs and broke up six passes. The Vols' seven sacks were their most since recording seven against Vanderbilt on Nov. 22, 2008. UT's top tackler on the day was Quart'e Sapp, who recorded nine stops. Linebacker Colton Jumper logged 3.5 TFLs. including 2.5 sacks.
- · Redshirt senior punter Trevor Daniel finished the game with eight punts for 391 yards, marking his best average in four games this season (48.9 average). In the first quarter, he kicked a 56-yard punt that pinned UMass at its own 3. His next punt for 53 yards pinned the Minutemen at their own 2

- Despite a strong showing from its defense and a late fourth-quarter drive with a chance to win the game with time expiring, Tennessee
 came up short in a 15-9 loss to South Carolina at Neyland Stadium.
- Making his first career start, redshirt freshman quarterback Jarrett Guarantano finished 11-for-18 for 133 yards and rushed 17 times for -2
 yards. Junior running back John Kelly gained 58 yards on 16 carries and also had two catches for 21 yards. Sophomore receiver Brandon
 Johnson caught three passes for 54 yards.
- The Vols enjoyed a fast start, racking up 133 yards of total offense in the first quarter, which was UT's most in a first quarter since posting 167 yards agaisnt Kentucky on Nov. 12, 2016.
- Tennessee had a 6-0 lead ofter the opening quarter as freshman placekicker Brent Cimaglia made field goals from 29 yards and 33 yards.
- After South Carolina kicker Parker White made a 47-yard field goal with 10:31 left in the second quarter, Cimaglia hit a 24-yarder with 33 seconds left in the half to push UT's lead to 9-3 at the break. Tennessee had 178 yards of total offense in the first half, including 124 rushing yards, which was the most by UT in a first half this season.
- The Gamecocks knotted the game at 9-9 with 1:02 left in the third quarter when A.J. Turner ran for a 20-yard touchdown. South Carolina
 did not convert the extra point as holder Danny Gordon mishandled the snap and threw the ball away with pressure bearing down on
 him.

- No. 1 Alabama controlled the 100th meeting between the two historic programs from start to finish. The Crimson Tide racked up 604
 yards of offense while limiting the Vols to just 108 yards.
- Alabama took a 21-0 lead into halftime thanks to two one-yard rushing scores by Bo Scarborough and an 11-yard rushing touchdown by Damien Harris.
- The Crimson Tide's lead grew to 28-0 when Jalen Hurts completed a 14-yard touchdown pass to Irv Smith Jr. early in the third quarter.
- Tennessee got on the scoreboard with 6:03 left in the third when Daniel Bituli intercepted a pass from Alabama backup quarterback Tua
 Tagovailoa and returned it 97 yards for a touchdown. It was UT's first pick-six since Jonathan Kongbo returned an interception 59 yards
 against Missouri on Nov. 19, 2016. Bituli's 97-yard interception return ranks as the fourth-longest in school history and the longest since
 Evan Berry's 100-yard return against Northwestern in the Outback Bowl on Jan. 1, 2016.
- Alabama responded with 17 unanswered points to close the game. Andy Pappanastos hit a 25-yard field goal with 3:13 left in the third
 quarter. In the fourth, Tagovailoa ran for a 23-yard score and threw a 60-yard touchdown pass to Henry Ruggs III.
- The Vols' best chance for an offensive score came midway through the fourth quarter. After D.J. Henderson forced a fumble by Alabama punt returner Xavian Marks and Rashaan Gaulden recovered the ball at the UA 15, Tennessee drove to inside the UT 10. A penalty and three John Kelly runs set up 4th-and-goal from the UA 5 and the series ended when Mack Wilson intercepted a desperation heave from Jarrett Guarantano.
- The game marked the second start of Guarantano's career. The redshirt freshman finished 11-for-18 for 133 yards and was sacked seven times.
- Junior running back John Kelly had 16 carries for 58 yards and alos had two receptions for 21 yards. Sophomore wide receiver Brandon Johnson had three catches for 54 yards.
- Freshman defensive back Shawn Shamburger led Tennessee defensively with 12 tackles and one sack. Redshirt sophomore linebacker Quart'e Sapp had 11 tackles. Sophomore defensive back Nigel Warrior posted seven tackles and one sack.

- Tennessee's five-game winning streak against Kentucky came to an end on Oct. 28 when the Wildcats edged the Vols, 29-26, in an exciting game that featured a turnover on the first offensive play and a Hail Mary on the final play at Kroger Field.
- The Vols posted a season-high four forced fumbles in the loss, marking UT's most since forcing four fumbles against Southern Miss on Sept. 8, 2007. The Vols also recovered all four fumbles, marking Tennessee's most recovered fumbles in one game since recovering four fumbles against Texas A&M on Jan. 1, 2005 in the Cotton Bowl.
- Freshman placekicker Brent Cimaglia made a career-high four field goals in the game, marking the most by a UT kicker since Aaron Medley made four field goals against Missouri in 2015.
- Just six seconds into the contest and on the first play from scrimmage, Tennessee senior defensive tackle Kendal Vickers hit UK running back Benny Snell behind the line of scrimmage for a tackle for loss, forcing a fumble in the process that was recovered by sophomore safety Niger Warrior at the Kentucky 15-yard line. Cimaglia made a 30-yard field goal on UT's ensuing possession, giving the Vols a 3-0 lead just 1:34 into the contest.
- · At the 10:16 mark of the first quarter, all players on both teams were assigned an unsportsmanlike penalty. Following unsportsmanlike penalties to any player following that resulted in ejections. With 1:14 remaining in the first half, UT's Daniel Bituli was disgualified from the game after receiving a second unsportsmanlike penalty. With 3:18 remaining, UT's Rashaan Gaulden was disqualified for the game after receiving an unsportsmanlike penalty. UK's Tavin Richardson was also ejected for an unsportsmanlike penalty the play.
- The game featured four lead changes. With 33 seconds left, UK guarterback Stephen Johnson completed a 10-play, 72-yard drive with an 11-yard TD run and topped it off by converting a two-point conversion pass to Benny Snell to give UK a 29-26 lead.
- With two seconds remaining in the game, UT redshirt freshman quarterback Jarrett Guarantano heaved a 48-yard pass down the field to Jeff George, who was tackled at the three-yard line as time expired.
- UT freshman running back Ty Chandler finished the game with career highs of 120 yards and 22 carries, becoming the first UT freshman to rush for 100 yards since Jalen Hurd had 122 yards and two TDs on 16 carries against lowa on Jan. 2, 2015.

- Celebrating its 94th Homecoming, Tennessee's stingy defense carried the Vols to a 24-10 win over Southern Miss. UT is now 72-19-3 all-time
 in Homecoming games. The Vols are 4-1 in homecoming games under head coach Butch Jones with wins in each of the last four years.
- The UT win marked the second time this season that the Vols have held an opponent to 10 points or fewer and their fourth time holding an opponent to under 20 points.
- With the win, Tennessee has now won 12-straight games against non-conference opponents. UT has won 28-straight games against non-conference, non-Power 5 teams since a 13-7 loss to Wyoming on Nov. 8, 2008, at Neyland Stadium.
- Junior running back John Kelly finished with 79 yards rushing and two touchdowns on 20 carries. He had a 20-yard rushing score with 5:15 left in the third and added a three-yard score at the 3:17 mark of the third.
- Tennessee took a 7-0 lead 4:01 into the game when redshirt freshman quarterback Jarrett Guarantano punched in a three-yard touchdown
- In the second quarter, Southern Miss answered with a 27-yard field goal by Parker Shaunfield. Aaron Medley connected on a 38-yard field goal with 2:42 left in the second to give the Vols a 10-3 lead heading into halftime.
- Kelly's two rushing scores in the third quarter resulted from a pair of turnovers. With 5:22 left in the third, Emmanuel Moseley intercepted
 a pass by USM's Keon Howard and returned it 19 yards to the USM 20, setting up Kelly's 20-yard touchdown run. On The Gold Eagles' next
 possession, Darrell Taylor strip sacked Howard and Rashaan Gaulden recovered the fumble at the USM 19. Kelly punctuated a four-play, 19yard drive with a three-yard touchdown run.
- Four UT freshmen offensive lineman experienced firsts on Saturday. Redshirt freshman Ryan Johnson made his first start at right guard and redshirt freshman Devante Brooks made his first start and first-ever appearance at right tackle. True freshman Riley Locklear also entered the game off the bench at right guard, making his first career appearance. Trey Smith made his ninth consecutive start of his freshman season on the offensive line and first at left tackle after starting the first eight games at right guard. Tennessee records show that Smith is likely the first Vols' true freshman to start at left tackle since at least 1988.
- Guarantano finished 9-for-13 for 102 yards. After Guarantano went down with an injury in the second quarter, true freshman quarterback Will
 McBride made his first career appearance and completed one of eight passes for 13 yards. McBride also gained seven yards on four carries.
- Gaulden led the team with nine tackles. Senior linebackers Elliott Berry and Colton Jumper had seven stops each.
- Senior Evan Berry returned the opening kickoff 46 yards.
- Redshirt senior punter Trevor Daniel punted eight times, averaging 49.2 yards per punt with three landing inside the 20, six for 50 or more
 yards and a long of 60.

- True freshman quarterback Will McBride made his first career start against Missouri and, despite a promising first half which featured the Vols trailing just 24-17 at halftime, the Tigers ran away with the game in the second half.
- · Missouri, which celebrated Senior Night before the game, racked up 659 yards of offense while limiting Tennesse to just 285 yards.
- After the Tigers took their second drive 82 yards to the end zone in eight plays, Tennessee answered two possessions later when
 sophomore safety intercepted MU quarterback Drew Lock and returned it 70 yards for a touchdown. After an extra point by senior Aaron
 Medley, the game was tied at 7-7. The interception marked Missouri's first pick six since Jonathan Kongbo returned a Lock interception 59
 yards for a touchdown on Nov. 19, 2016, in Neyland Stadium.
- With 1:15 left in the first half McBride connected with senior tight end Ethan Wolf for a 19-yard touchdown pass while the freshman quarterback was getting hit. Medley's ensuing extra point tied the game at 17-17. McBride was 6-for-9 for 59 yards on the 15-play, 66-yard drive
- · Larry Rountree capped a five-play, 75-yard MU drive with a one-yard score as Missouri responded with 33 unanswered points.
- McBride finished 16-for-32 for 139 yards with one touchdown and two interceptions. He also led the team in rushing, carrying the ball
 14 times for 63 yards with one fumble lost. McBride is the first Tennessee true freshman to start since Joshua Dobbs started against
 Kentucky on Nov. 30, 2013. He is the ninth true freshman to start a game at quarterback in Tennessee's 121-year history.
- Freshman running back Ty Chandler had eight carries for 33 yards. Wolf finished with three catches for 45 yards and one touchdown.
 Sophomore receiver Brandon Johnson caught three passes for 45 yards.
- Junior safety Micah Abernathy led the team with 13 tackles and redshirt sophomore linebacker Quart'e Sapp added 10 stops.
- Warrior finished the game with five tackles, the 70-yard pick six and one blocked extra point. He blocked the extra point following Lock's 20-yard touchdown pass to Jonathan Johnson wiht 13:21 left in the game.

Despite a 287-281 advantage in total offense, Tennessee committed two costly turnovers and the LSU's potent running game proved to be too much for the Vols, who took a 30-10 loss to the Tigers on Nov. 18 at Neyland Stadium.

- UT redshirt freshman quarterback Jarrett Guarantano went 13-for-23 for 239 yards and one touchdown. Junior running back John Kelly gained 57 yards on 25 carries and also had three catches for 31 yards. Sophomore receiver Marquez Callaway caught two passes for 72 vards and one touchdown.
- The Tigers gained 200 rushing yards with Derrius Guice (24 carries, 94 yards, one touchdown) and Darrell Williams (seven carries, 69 vards, two scores) leading the way.
- LSU took an early 3-0 lead after a Callaway muffed a punt and the Tigers' Russell Gage pounced on the ball at the UT 15. Connor Culp made a 30-yard field goal.
- After Aaron Medley made a 45-yard field goal on UT's following series. Callaway fumbled LSU's next punt, setting the Tigers up at the UT 19. Three plays later, Williams scored on a 10-yard touchdown run and Culp's extra point gave LSU a 10-3 lead.
- On UT's third possession, senior tight end Ethan Wolf caught a seven-yard pass from Guarantano, giving him 958 career receiving yards and moving him past Luke Stocker (956 yards from 2007-10) for the third-most all-time among Tennessee tight ends. Only Reggie Harper (1,141 yards from 1977-80) and Mychal Rivera (1,018 from 2010-12) have more receiving yards among Tennessee tight ends.
- · With 2:08 left in the first half, quarterback Danny Etling extended the Tigers' lead to 17-3 on a 13-yard touchdown run.
- Guarantano hit Callaway for a 46-yard touchdown pass with 1:23 left in the half and Medley's extra point put UT down just 17-10 going into halftime.
- · LSU pulled away with a pair of third-quarter rushing scores. Guice scored from three yards out and Williams scored on a six-yard run.
- With 16 seconds left in the third quarter, Guarantano heaved a pass down the right sideline to Jeff George for a 60-yard gain. It was Guarantano's longest pass of his career and it was the second-longest UT offensive play of the season.
- Redshirt sophomore linebacker Quart'e Sapp led the Vols with 11 tackles. Sophomores Nigel Warrior and Daniel Bituli and redshirt senior Kendal Vickers each had eight stops.
- Redshirt senior punter Trevor Daniel finished the game with four punts for 204 yards and a 51.0 average. He also had two punts of 50 or more vards.

- After a close start, Vanderbilt (5-7, 1-7 SEC) took a 21-14 lead shortly before halftime with a touchdown. While Tennessee (4-8, 0-8) came
 within four points on a 49-yard field goal by Aaron Medley, the Commodores pulled away and eventually out-gained Tennessee 529 to
 238 yards.
- Vanderbilt quarterback Kyle Shurmur completed 20-of-31 passes for 283 yards and four touchdowns, and running back Ralph Webb rushed for 163 yards and two touchdowns.
- Redshirt freshman quarterback Jarrett Guarantano completed 14-of-22 passes for 183 yards and two touchdowns. Sophomore wide receiver Brandon Johnson recorded 107 receiving yards, his second career game with at least 100 yards.
- The Vols honored their 22 seniors before their final home game at Neyland Stadium. This year's senior class combined for 29 wins over their past four seasons and three-consecutive bowl game victories for the first time in program history.
- Redshirt senior Kendal Vickers capped his career by starting his 38th consecutive game at defensive tackle for the Vols. In addition,
 Vickers was the only Vol to serve as a captain for every game in 2017. The Havelock, N.C., native wrapped up his career by playing in 43
 games and started every game of his sophomore, junior and senior seasons.
- Ethan Wolf finished the game with two catches for 40 yards and a touchdown, giving him 998 career receiving yards. He ranks third on
 UT's all-time receiving yardage list among tight ends. An early third quarter reception from Jarrett Guarantano was the 90th catch of
 Wolf's career, making him the second Vol tight end to record 90 receptions in a career. Only Reggie Harper (98 receptions from 1977-80)
 had more. Only Reggie Harper (1,141 yards from 1977-80) and Mychal Rivera (1,018 from 2010-12) have more receiving yards among
 Tennessee tight ends.
- Redshirt senior punter Trevor Daniel wrapped up his career by setting the Tennessee punting average for a single season (47.5) and for a
 career (45.9). The former walk-on from Dickson, Tenn., bettered the previous single-season mark of 46.9 set in 1982 by Jimmy Colquitt.
 Daniel's career mark of 45.9 also breaks Jimmy Colquitt's career mark of 43.9 (1981-84).
